


Your first day – What to expect?

Upon arrival at 72 Sterling Road, Toronto, ON, there is free parking across the street; please enter door at 72 Sterling and advise Security you are here for the Orientation.

Hours of work

Salaried employees -

Our standard work day is 7.5 hours per day for a 37.5 hour work week. As the factory is a multi-shift operation, you may be required to be flexible with the hours. Please review hours of work with your manager.

Hourly employees -

The collective agreement defines the hours of work for employees covered under the bargaining units. You will receive your copy of the collective agreement on your first day of orientation.



















Lunch Options

Sterling Road is a peanut, tree nut free facility. Your lunch and snacks must be absolutely free from any kind of nuts.

- We have two cafeterias onsite on the 2nd and 4th floor.
- You may bring your own lunch or purchase frozen meals from our Company store.
- We have fridges, microwave ovens, vending machines with hot and cold beverages and snacks available in both cafeterias.
- An approved list of restaurants that you can order-in from is available to all employees and posted on our notice boards.
